

Biopsy Wound Care

After 24 hours:

- 1. Remove bandage.
- 2. Gently cleanse wound site with warm soapy water (this may be done while showering).
- 3. Air dry 5-10 minutes prior to applying Vaseline or Aquaphor.
- 4. Keep covered with a Band-Aid or non-stick pad and paper tape.
- 5. Repeat steps 1-4 twice daily until site is well-healed.

What to expect while healing

- The wound or area around the biopsy may appear pink/dark pink in color.
- Areas on the face typically take 1-2 weeks to heal, while areas on trunk and extremities tend to take up to one month.
- You may experience slight tenderness.
- If excessive bleeding occurs, apply firm pressure on the site for 20 minutes. Replace the bandage with a clean, dry dressing. Is after 30 minutes, bleeding has not stopped, please call our office at (941)474-8811 or go to your local Urgent Care/ER.
- We typically call patients within two weeks with biopsy results. If you have not received a call or message within two weeks, please contact our office.
- Please be aware that <u>all biopsies</u> will be sent to a lab for the tissue to be diagnosed. The lab may send a separate bill for this service.
